Nellie had to beg and call in favors to get the part, a relatively small one at that. During the filming, the American cast and crew couldn't understand half of what Gottfried said because he spoke with such a strong accent. He constantly ranted in German when he was unhappy with a performance or scene or camera shot. He destroyed sets and ripped costumes that didn't meet his standards. Nellie had to talk a number of actors/crew members into NOT walking off the set. But the results were amazing and it won outstanding acclaim for the Costuming.
